ABOUT THE PROPERTY

Present day California can be a busy and bustling place, but Creston Cemetery is in the center of a community that enjoys the quiet, country lifestyle. If more excitement is needed, several lively towns are within an easy drive, such as San Luis Obispo, Atascadero, Paso Robles and Morro Bay, each offering their own Central California specialty.

This is a pioneer cemetery of those first settlers, with the oldest headstone dating back to 1887. Many of the first families who immigrated from Europe can be found buried here. A great deal of original wooden and granite headstones have text and prayers in German. The Holzinger family, who first came to Creston in 1885, still owns the surrounding ranch land outside the borders of Creston Cemetery.

Lizards are out in the summer days, along with rabbits and ground squirrels. Large hawks, owls and ospreys are commonly spotted in Creston and in the trees at the cemetery. By offering natural burial, this helps to keep their habitat healthy for them.

UNIQUENESS OF THE PROPERTY

Creston Cemetery, sometimes referred to as the Cowboy Cemetery, has always been cared for by the community. Local boy scout troops once assisted with the maintenance, as well as neighbors, who would drive their mowers from several ranches over.

Surrounded by cattle ranches, vineyards, rolling hills and mature oak trees, Creston has been making a name for itself for its beautiful views and new world wine production
